### Program Speakers

**Marybeth Richardson** is the regional director of DEP's southern Maine regional office in Portland. She has been with the Department since the early 1990's working mostly within the Land Resource Bureau as a supervisor and project manager, where she was involved in administering the Site Location Law, Stormwater Law, and Natural Resources Protection Act in both licensing and enforcement. She has a bachelor's degree in environmental science from Rutgers University.

**Alison Sirois** is the new (July 2016) regional Licensing and Compliance manager for the Land Resource Bureau at the DEP's southern Maine office in Portland where she is responsible for administering the Site Location Law, Stormwater Law, and Natural Resources Protection Act for both licensing and enforcement. She is also the DEP Maine Healthy Beaches Coordinator. Alison previously worked for the Maine Department of Marine Resources where she was both scientist and manager for shellfisheries and public health along the coast.
