

MSLS and Sunday River COVID-19 Guidelines to protect participants and guests. We greatly appreciate your cooperation.

Please note all registrations, participant, guest, and exhibitor imply accepting responsibility for following Sunday River Resort and MSLS 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Conference COVID19 Guidelines:

- 1) Sunday River Mask Use – “Following CDC recommendations, fully-vaccinated guests and Team Members are not required to wear a mask. Unvaccinated guests and Team Members must wear a mask indoors, and outdoors when six feet of distance cannot be maintained. Face coverings should be dry and unsoiled, have two or more layers, completely cover the nose and mouth with no holes or mesh, and fit snugly against the face.”
- 2) MSLS Event Attendance – Vaccination is highly preferable to protect each other and the many older founding members, past presidents, and the intra-state and international visitors we expect to host. We appreciate everyone’s consideration for the health of their fellow members in our Society and profession.
- 3) If you choose to attend unvaccinated, please plan on observing all real-time existing CDC masking, social distancing, and other preventative measures applicable for the US, Maine, and Oxford County. Please also complete a rapid test on your own to obtain results timed prior to your travel. Do not attend if your results are positive; a full registration refund will be issued.
- 4) MSLS will observe real-time U.S. CDC’s updated face-covering guidance that recommends all people, regardless of vaccination status, wear face coverings in indoor, public settings in areas with “substantial” or “high” levels of community transmission. Recently, Oxford County was in the “moderate” range but is now in “high” status and vaccinated attendees do need to mask but please be aware that this is always subject to change based on the latest information.
- 5) Regardless of vaccination status, if you are experiencing symptoms associated with COVID19, do not attend; a full registration refund will be issued.
- 6) If you bring a guest or guests, please expect them to follow the same guidelines as registrants.
- 7) MSLS will provide in conjunction with Sunday River hand sanitizing availability and function room ventilation information.

We realize this is an extensive level of protocols which might be seen as an inconvenience by some. Our overarching goal is to provide a safe environment in which to happily celebrate our postponed 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary as we gather together for the first time in over 20 months.
